

Joint Communiqué # 58
Havana, Cuba, August 30, 2015

The delegations of the Government of Colombia and the FARC - EP in Havana continue working on topics related to the items on Victims, End of the Conflict and de-escalation measures.

During this cycle, the sub-commission on Gender of the Dialogue Table received 10 women's organizations who made several recommendations on topics such as gender and sexual violence in the conflict.

The group of jurists also moved forward in the discussions on mechanisms within the Comprehensive System of Truth, Justice, Reparation and Guarantees of Non-Repetition.

As of this coming Monday, August 31, the operations for the decontamination of explosives in the rural settlement of El Orejón in Briceño (Antioquia) will continue, following the review and update of the operational procedures applicable to the pilot project on decontamination and removal of land mines, carried out by both delegations and the Norwegian People's Aid.

A new dialogue cycle will start this coming September 11.
